

# Remembrance Service & Requiem Concert

St. Oliver's Parish Choir, combined with members of the Festival Chorale (s) of Fairfield Glad and North Georgia, present a special afternoon performance of remembrance to honor all those from St. Oliver Plunkett that have died in the past year. The program will begin with the reading of names followed by a tolling of the bells. The performance will continue with the combined choirs presenting REQUIEM by Bradley Ellingboe, with chamber orchestra accompaniment and guest soloist Amanda Christine Caban.

Ellingboe's REQUIEM was composed in 2002 and since then has been performed all over the world. This composition is a large choral work that combines the Latin requiem texts with famous English Christian text such as *The Lord's Prayer*, *Death Be Not Proud* by John Donne (1572-1631). Psalm 22 and an *Evensong* by George Herbert (1593-1633).

A REQUIEM is a musical composition of the components of the Roman Catholic Mass for the repose of the souls of the dead. We hope you will join us in the church at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 4 for this special Remembrance Service and Requiem Concert.
